"Tutumangao is the one off bald spur that I've txt you a photo of where we dropped in, up bald spur till it flattens out mid way up, then up for a further 20mins type thing, as it steepens up again we cut climbers left (canyon right!) and bush bashed down into the valley, you're better to go a bit higher than you think you need to.

No special gear or rigging required, low key trees etc, longest pitch was only around 25 - 30m however we ended up doing two shorted ones down the bottom end off one tree and pulling through from the bottom, it that makes sense. From memory we took a 50m, 35m and a 100 which never came out of the pack...
