<a href="#">Eager Beaver Canyon, Wairarapa</a>	166	Double bolted anchors installed at the 3 main pitches
<a href="#">Stonewall Canyon, Wairarapa</a>	169	R1 now 23m on TR, with optional deviation bolt. Double bolt anchors for all pitches.
<a href="#">Barefoot Burn, Nelson Lakes</a>	232	Double bolted anchors installed for about half the pitches
<a href="#">Griffin Creek, Taramakau Valley</a>	262	New anchors and route description for R8-10 "Bodengo Falls"
<a href="#">Curtis Creek, Otira Valley</a>	272	Bolted anchors installed. Two additional pitches added upstream of book entry point.
<a href="#">Dorothy Creek, Lake Kaniere</a>	279	This canyon has been completely destroyed in a huge rain event, March 2019.
<a href="#">Twin Creek, Otira Valley</a>	304	Canyon extended above and below guidebook topo. 17 pitches to 55m
<a href="#">Sharplin Falls, Mt Sommers</a>	334	Bolted anchors installed. Changed exit route due to destroyed bridge.
<a href="#">Robinson Creek, Haast Pass</a>	381	Road bridge upgrade: Water gauge no longer relevant. Significant rockfall at R8
<a href="#">Ore Stream, Wanaka</a>	402	New anchors installed. R4/R5 numbering incorrect on topo and description.
<a href="#">Camp Creek, Wanaka</a>	406	Canyon wall has completely collapsed. Canyon is no longer safe to descend.
<a href="#">Hester Pinney Waterfall, Wanaka</a>	420	Relatively stable and passable landslide in 'very narrow section'
